CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BILL GOODMAN

of 17805 Highway 101, South, Tillamook, State of Oregon 97141, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Munson or Morrison Creek

a tributary of Tillamook River for the purpose of irrigation of 42.5 acres

under Permit No. 378 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from June 15, 1910

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.53 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 28, T2S, R9W, WM; 3025.7 feet South and 3,555 feet East from NW Corner, Section 28;

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 28, T2S, R9W, WM; 270 feet North and 790 feet East from W 1/4 Corner, Section 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4
15.5 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
17.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4

Section 28

Township 2 South, Range 9 West, WM


This certificate is issue to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 19, 1972, and together with Certificate of Water Right recorded at page 44997, Volume 37, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 751.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
