## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That SCHLEGEL BROTHERS

of % Irwin Schlegel, Route 1, Box 161, Banks, State of Oregon 97106, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bledsoe Creek, unnamed spring branch and reservoir constructed under Permit R-2009

a tributary of East Dairy Creek irrigation of 11.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 24836 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 8, 1957

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, being 0.015 cfs from Bledsoe Creek and 0.015 cfs from unnamed spring branch

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Bledsoe Creek:  $NW_4$  SW4, Section 28; unnamed spring branch:  $NE_4$  SE4, Section 29, T2N, R3W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-2009,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.4 acres NE½ SE½

Section 29
Township 2 North, Range 3 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 29790, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 29, 1982.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
