## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ESTATE of U. S. ALDERMAN

of Dayton, State of Oregon 97114, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Willamette River and Lambert Slough

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 364.2 acres

under Permit No. 13847 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 23, 1939 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.55 cubic feet per second, being 2.80 cfs from Willamette River and 1.75 cfs from Lambert Slough

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the River: Lot 5, Section 14, and Lot 7, Section 24, T5S, R3W, WM; and Lots 1, 2, and 3, Section 35, T4S, R3W, WM; Slough: SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 3 in DLC 52; Lots 10 and 12, Section 3; NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 10 in DLC 53; and SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 10 in DLC 54, T5S, R3W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


