CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That R. F. SMICOTTEN (W.L. Stirling, Agt., Walla Walla, Washington)

of Huston, State of Texas has a right to the use of the waters of Middle Branch of Mud Creek, a tributary of East Branch of Mud Creek, for the purpose of Irrigation, domestic and stock use.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 5, at page 322; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1908.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed .4925 cubic foot per second; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

8.5 acres in the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter; 30.9 acres in the Southwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-one (21), Township Six (6) North, Range Thirty-five (35) East of Willamette Meridian, being a total of 39.4 acres.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
