CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GARY WILLIAM DEGARMO

of 6333 Sterling Creek Road, Jacksonville, State of Oregon 97530, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well and a sump

a tributary of Sterling Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 5.0 acres

under Permit No. G-7246 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 17, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.056 cubic feet of water per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 32, T38S, R2W, WM; Well - 680 feet North and 880 feet West; Sump - 530 feet North and 820 feet West both from SE Corner, Section 32

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 32
Township 38 South, Range 2 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
