## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** CONSOLIDATED PIPELINE COMPANY, INC.

of 2275 Webster Road, Grants Pass, State of Oregon 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed drainageway and Rogue West Lake Reservoir, constructed under Permit R-5290 a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.7 acre and supplemental irrigation of 4.3 acres

under Permit No. 33494 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from September 25, 1968 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 24, T36S, R6W, WM; 100 feet North and 630 feet West from SE Corner, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 24

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-5290

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

## PRIMARY IRRIGATION

0.7 acre NE 1/4 NW 1/4  
Section 24


## SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION

4.3 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4  
Section 24  
Township 36 South, Range 6 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
