CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatWILLIS CONANT and
CECIL D. and MILDRED RUDDICK

of Route 1, Box 228, Nyssa, State of Oregon 97913, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Snake River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 42.5 acres

under Permit No. 34145 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from February 6, 1969 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.06 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 31, T20S, R47E, WM; 1 - 2,070 feet South and 860 feet East; 2 - 2,580 feet South and 500 feet East both from the NW Corner, Section 31,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


12.1 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4
7.5 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 36
Township 20 South, Range 46 East, WM

22.9 acres Lot 3 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4)
Section 31
Township 20 South, Range 47 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
