CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FLOYD VENABLE

of 6555 Blackwell Road, Central Point, State of Oregon 97501, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Bear Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 5.2 acres

under Permit No. 838 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from September 6, 1911

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic feet per second, if available at the original point of diversion; SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 21, T36S, R2W, WM; 99 feet North and 1,428 feet East from SW Corner, Section 21

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected within Hall DLC 50, Section 28, T36S, R2W, WM; 730 feet South and 2,120 feet West from NE Corner, Section 28

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.2 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Hall DLC 50 Section 28 Township 36 South, Range 2 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 22, 1974, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 44187, Volume 36 and page 51329, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 1056.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
