CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE BOARD OF CONTROL

of Salem, State of Oregon 97310, has a right to the use of the waters of Mill Creek

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of (see below)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 14, at page 357; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from (see below)

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed (see below)

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

A right to the use of 1,615,562 gallons of water per 24 hours which includes the 1,200,000 gallons per 24 hours from North Santiam River for domestic, stock and institutional uses at the State Penitentiary, State Hospital and grounds, and State Capitol buildings and grounds with a date of priority of 1865, the place of use being described as follows:

That part of the Morgan L. Savage DLC 79 within Section 25,
That part of the Samuel Parker DLC 77 within Section 25,

all Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM, now owned by the
State of Oregon

ALSO: The State Capitol Group of buildings and grounds within the City of Salem.

A right for the use of not to exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second per acre and 2½
acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each
year for irrigation of 7.0 acres from Mill Creek with a date of priority of 1891.
The place of use for irrigation being described as follows:

That part of Sections 17 and 18
Township 8 South, Range 2 West, WM
now owned by the State of Oregon


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the
prior certificate recorded at page 14836, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
Director entered on January 19, 1956, approving Transfer O-22, and NOT canceled
by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 11,
1964, in Volume 13, page 371, Special Order Record.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture
or abandonment.

*And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.*
