CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

OREGON STATE BOARD OF CONTROL

of Salem, State of Oregon 97310, has
a right to the use of the waters of
North Santiam River

a tributary of Santiam River for the purpose of
domestic, stock, institutional purposes, and upkeep of grounds connected with
state institutions;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Marion County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 14, at page 354; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1856

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1,200,000 gallons
in 24 hours.

The point of diversion is located in the

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

- That part of the Isaac Baker DLC 81 within Section 24,
- That part of the Josiah L. Parrish DLC 61 within Sections 24 and 25,
- That part of the Morgan L. Savage DLC 79 within Section 25,
- That part of the Samuel Parker DLC 77 within Section 25,
- That part of the Webley Houxhurst DLC 78 within Sections 25 and 36,
- That part of the Alvan F. Waller DLC 46 within Sections 25 and 36

all Township 7 South, Range 3 West, WM, now owned by the State of
Oregon

ALSO: all of Blocks 82, 83, 85 and 86, City of Salem, Marion County

ALSO:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Block 1, in Waldo's Addition to the City of Salem, according to Column 1, page 43, Record of Town Plats for Marion County, Oregon, thence westerly along the southerly line of Court Street to a point which is 372.37 feet in a westerly direction from the northwest corner of Block 84 of the recorded plat of the City of Salem; thence in a southerly direction parallel with the west line of said Block 84, 330 feet to a point on the northerly line of State Street; thence in an easterly direction along the said north line of State Street to the southeast corner of said Block 1 in Waldo's Addition; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Block 1 in Waldo's Addition 330 feet to the place of beginning.

ALSO: Block 2 in Waldo's Addition to the City of Salem.

ALSO:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Block 2 in Robert Addition to the City of Salem, Marion County, Oregon, and running thence southerly on the west boundary line of said Block 2, 50 feet 4 inches; thence easterly parallel with the south line of said Block 2 and the north line of State Street, 165 feet more or less to the west boundary line of the alley running northerly and southerly through said Block 2; thence northerly along the west line of said alley, 50 feet 4 inches to the northeast corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Block 2; thence westerly along the north boundary line of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Block 2 to the place of beginning, all situated in said Roberts Addition to the City of Salem, Marion County, Oregon.

ALSO:

Beginning at a point on the west line of Block 2 in Roberts Addition to the City of Salem, Marion County, Oregon, 124 feet south of the northwest corner of said block; thence east parallel with Court Street, 158 feet to the alley; thence south parallel with the east line of 12th Street, 41 feet; thence west parallel with the south line of Court Street, 158 feet to the west line of said block; thence north on the west line of said block, 41 feet to the place of beginning.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 14903, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 11, 1964, in Volume 13, page 371, Special Order Record.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
