CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W.B. HAMILTON

of Echo, State of Oregon 97826, has a right to the use of the waters of Butter Creek

a tributary of Umatilla River for the purpose of irrigation of 89.7 acres, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 3, at page 250; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1864

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.498 cubic feet per second

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 5.0 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4
40.0 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4
40.0 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4
4.7 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 8
Township 3 North, Range 28 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 2668, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on September 27, 1982.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
