CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** That ARTHUR R. and MARY M. ANDERSON

of Route 4, The Dalles, State of Oregon 97058, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Anderson Well

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 8.7 acres

under Permit No. G-1549 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 1, 1960 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 6, T1N, R13E, WM; 60 feet South and 775 feet West from NE Corner, Section 6.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 2.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 31
- 6.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 32


