## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** JACK O. SWECK and  
JACK E. CAVENDER

of Monument, , State of Oregon 97864 , has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
North Fork John Day River

a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of  
irrigation of 68.8 acres

under Permit No. 38853 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from  
November 13, 1973  
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
1.22 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 1, T9S, R27E, WM;  
1,170 feet South and 340 feet West from Center 1/4 Corner, Section 1

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right  
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited  
to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated  
during the irrigation season of each year

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right  
is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.2 acres Lot 3 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4)  
3.4 acres Lot 4 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4)  
18.0 acres SW 1/4 NW 1/4  
6.3 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4  
24.8 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
9.2 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4  
0.4 acre SW 1/4 SW 1/4  
2.5 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4


