CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

PHILLIP D. ATWATER

of Route 1, Box 142, Hood River, State of Oregon 97031, has a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of Neal Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 4.2 acres and power purposes

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 469; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1903

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.36 cubic feet per second being 0.06 cfs for irrigation and 3.30 cfs for power purposes

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.2 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 24 Township 2 North, Range 10 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 3832, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on December 13, 1982.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
