for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-1180 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 23, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SW_4 SW_4 , Section 21, T6N, R35E, WM; 900 feet East and 620 feet North from SW Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

22.8 acres SW_4 SW_4 Section 21 Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 33559, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on January 4, 1983.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
