## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** JAMES P. and JOAN T. PETTY

of Route 1, Box 110, Joseph, State of Oregon 97846, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River

a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of irrigation of 31.3 acres

under Permit No. 28864 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from June 11, 1963

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.40 cubic foot per second of water

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 31, T2S, R45E, WM; 550 feet South and 800 feet West from NE Corner Section 31

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, 3 1/2 acre-feet provided further that the right to use water is limited to the period when the flow of the Lower Grande Ronde River is more than 300 cfs at USGS Gage 3325 and more than 420 cfs at Oregon-Washington border

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.8 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
5.6 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4  
7.2 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4

1.6 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4  
6.4 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4  
6.6 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4  
0.1 acre NE 1/4 SW 1/4


## Section 15
