CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That W.B. BALES and C.V. BALES

of Dayville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of irrigation of 2.0 acres

under Permit No. 4481 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from March 12, 1920 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, T11S, R26E, WM; 1160 feet South and 1830 feet West from S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner, Section 31, T10S, R26E, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 6
Township 11 South, Range 26 East, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 5785, Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 7, 1983, approving Transfer Application 5172.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
