CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GLENN C. BIRDSEYE

of 3793 Rogue River Highway, Gold Hill, State of Oregon 97525, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Birdseye Reservoir 1 constructed under Permit R-6249

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 15.0 acres

under Permit No. 38833 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 28, 1974 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within D. Birdseye DLC 41, Section 34, T36S, R4W, WM; Creek - 80 feet North and 1110 feet East, Reservoir - 1740 feet North and 1360 feet East both from S 1/4 Corner, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~-----of one cubic-foot per second per acre,~~ a diversion of not to exceed 4 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.0 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within D. Birdseye DLC 41
4.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within D. Birdseye DLC 41
Section 34
Township 36 South, Range 4 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
