CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GLENN C. BIRDSEYE

of 3793 Rogue River Highway, Gold Hill, State of Oregon 97525, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Birdseye Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of stock

under Permit No. 36679 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from February 11, 1972

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 34, T36S, R4W, WM; 80 feet North and 1,110 feet East from S 1/4 Corner, Section 34.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within D. Birdseye DLC 41
 SW 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within D. Birdseye DLC 41
 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within D. Birdseye DLC 41
 Section 34
 Township 36 South, Range 4 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
