CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHARLES M. COLTON

of Baker, State of Oregon 97814, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Powder River

a tributary of Snake River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 77.3 acres

under Permit No. 25558 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from June 4, 1958 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.99 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 17, T8S, R40E, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

40.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
37.3 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 4
Township 8 South, Range 40 East, WM


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 28777, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 30, 1983.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
