CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That EMORY E. MOORE

of Emory Moore Ranch, Kings Valley, State of Oregon 97353, has made

proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to store the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary of Maxfield Creek in Emory Moore Reservoir, appropriated under Application 37298, Permit 27929 and Application 35053, Permit 27920

for the purposes of
irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-2862, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 13, 1961 for 139.6 acre-feet and May 14, 1962 for 6.4 acre-feet

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 146.0 acre-feet


