CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That HENRY J. GRASS, M.D.

of Route 2, Box 11-F, Banks, State of Oregon 97106, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and Hank's Lake constructed under Permit R-1869

a tributary of West Dairy Creek for the purpose of recreation

under Permit No. 24224 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from May 11, 1956

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.24 cubic foot per second, during the irrigation season of each year

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 35, T2N, R4W, WM; 1000 feet South and 2070 feet West from the NE Corner Section 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 26
NW 1/4 NE 1/4
Section 35
Township 2 North, Range 4 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in character of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 1, 1977, and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 44922, Volume 36, State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 29783.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
