## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Route 1, Box 29, Baker , State of Oregon 97814 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Gardner Spring

a tributary of Washington Gulch for the purpose of domestic use for one family including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area

under Permit No. 42035 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from August 30, 1977

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $\,$  NE  $\,$  1/4 NE  $\,$  1/4, Section 15, Township 9 South, Range 39 East, WM; 1210 feet South and 110 feet West from NE Corner, Section 15

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 10 Township 9 South, Range 39 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
