## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** *That* ERVIN WHETZEL

of Star Route 1, Box 10A, Days Creek, State of Oregon 97429, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director. of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 17.0 acres and domestic use for two families

under Permit No. 38457 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 24, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.22 cubic foot per second, being 0.21 cfs for irrigation and 0.01 cfs for domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 5 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 22, Lot 8 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4), Section 21, T30S, R4W, WM; 1 - 90 feet North and 560 feet East; 2 - 390 feet North and 330 feet West both from W 1/4 Corner, Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:


Domestic and 0.5 acre Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4)  
2.3 acres Lot 8 (SE 1/4 NE 1/4)  
Section 21

2.0 acres Lot 4 (NW 1/4 NW 1/4)  
Domestic and 12.2 acres Lot 5 (SW 1/4 NW 1/4)  
Section 22  
Township 30 South, Range 4 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
