## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**                      ROBERT S. and JANET L. SCHAFER

of 972 Brumbach Road, Roseburg                      , State of Oregon 97470                      , has made  
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of  
North Umpqua River

a tributary of                      Umpqua River                      for the purpose of  
irrigation of 0.6 acre and domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 41396                      and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in  
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from  
January 20, 1977  
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.013 cubic foot per second, being 0.008 cfs for irrigation and 0.005 cfs for  
domestic

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the                      NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 10, T26S, R3W, WM;  
490 feet South and 1140 feet West from Center, Section 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right  
existing for the same lands, shall be limited to                      one-eightieth                      of one cubic foot per second  
per acre,                      or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further  
limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre  
irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall  
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right  
is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 0.6 acre NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
Section 10  
Township 26 South, Range 3 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place  
of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the  
Water Policy Review Board.
