## CENTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Critily That Ohas. S. Dykstra

of Oregon City , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Unnamed Spring, tributary of Holcomb Greek a tributary of Willamette Watershed for the purpose of domestic & irrigation under Permit No. 6211 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 25, 1924;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to any smount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

## 0.01 cubic foot per wound.

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper to the officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its superclark in case of rotation.

A rescription of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is apported and (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: One (1) acre in the Southeast Cuarter of the Northeast Cuarter

(SEARE) of Section Twenty-seven [27], Township Two South, Range Two East of the Willamette Meridian, in Clackamas County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
