of 12850 Southwest 3rd, Beaverton ,State of Oregon 97005 ,has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director. of a right to the use of the waters of Johnson Creek, Foothill Creek and Commonwealth Lake Reservoir enlarged under Permit R-6488

a tributary of Cedar Mill Creek recreation

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 40685 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the rights hereby confirmed dates from May 10, 1976

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.6 cubic foot per second, being 0.5 cfs from Johnson Creek, and 0.1 cfs from Foothill Creek and reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, both within L. Hall DLC 43, Section 4, TlS, RlW, WM; Johnson Creek - 250 feet North and 170 feet West; Foothill Creek - 300 feet South and 1360 feet West, both from E 1/4 Corner, Section 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a confidence of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right

is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within L. Hall DLC 43

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
