proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to store the waters of unnamed drainage, tributary of East Fork Main Pine Creek (Snake River) appropriated under PERmit 26491, in East Lake Reservoir

for the purposes of irrigation and supplemental irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-2309, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 7, 1959

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 42.5 acre-feet

The reservoir is located in

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 10
Township 6 South, Range 45 East, WM.

This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the amount of water stored and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 39118, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
