CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatHERBERT LUMBER COMPANY and
C and D LUMBER COMPANY

of PO Box 27, Riddle, State of Oregon 97469, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of general sawmill use within the irrigation season of each year

under Permit No. 18628 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 17, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.2 cubic foot per second, if available at the original point of diversion; NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 16, T28S, R6W, WM; being 0.05 cfs for Herbert Lumber Company and 0.15 cfs for C and D Lumber Company

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, as projected within Cowles DLC 37, Section 12, T30S, R6W, WM; 1400 feet North and 200 feet West from SE Corner DLC 37.

~~The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,~~ shall be further limited to not to exceed 40 acre-feet during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 3, 1977 and together with certificate of water right recorded at page 44820, Volume 36 State Record of Water Right Certificates, supersedes Certificate 20438.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Policy Review Board with an effective date prior to this right.
