CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

C and D LUMBER COMPANY

of PO Box 27, Riddle, State of Oregon 97469, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Judd Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of general sawmill use

under Permit No. 17372 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 18, 1946 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.023 cubic foot per second with 0.013 cfs restricted to use during the irrigation season of each year

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, as projected within Wm. W. Judd DLC 51, Section 13, T30S, R6W, WM; 850 feet South and 300 feet West from NE Corner DLC 51.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4
NE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 13

Township 30 South, Range 6 West, WM

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use of water approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 3, 1977 and together with the same order which canceled a portion of the right, supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 17336, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
