CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OPAL JARVIS

of Portland, State of Oregon, has
 a right to the use of the waters of
 Cow Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River for the purpose of
 irrigation of 10.4 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Douglas County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
 the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 14, at page 202; that the priority of the right
 thereby confirmed dates from 1901

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 8.7 miners inches
 during the irrigation season from April 1 to October 1 of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T32S, R5W, WM; 80 feet
 North and 630 feet West from SE Corner, Section 19.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
 follows:

5.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 5.4 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 19
 Township 32 South, Range 5 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the
 prior certificate recorded at page 49657, Volume 43, State Record of Water Right
 Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources
 Director entered on June 29, 1981 amending Transfer Application 4268.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the
 water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture
 or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
 The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein
 described.
