CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JAY R. and MARGARET POTTER

of Echo Drive, Box 1715, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and irrigation of 1.5 acres

under Permit No. 36892 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 8, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 cfs for domestic use and 0.02 cfs for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Dixon DLC 41, Section 23, T26S, R5W, WM; 380 feet South and 500 feet West from NE Corner NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.2 acre NE 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Dixon DLC 41
 Domestic and 1.3 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within Dixon DLC 41
 Section 23
 Township 26 South, Range 5 West, WM

Land upon which water used is more explicitly described as
 Lot 11 Echo Bend Estates First Addition

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
