## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

RICHARD M. STANFORD

of 1780 Wild River Drive, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of lawn and garden not to exceed one-half acre in area under Permit No. 41245 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1976 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within W. Trask DLC 40, Section 14, T26S, R4W, WM; 920 feet North and 140 feet West from SW Corner, NW 1/4 SE 1/4.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within W. Trask DLC 40  
Section 14  
Township 26 South, Range 4 West, WM

Land upon which water used is more explicitly described as Lot 2, Wild River Drive Estates Subdivision.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
