CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That C. L. BECRAFT

of Lakeview, State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Drews Creek, a tributary of Goose Lake; for the purpose of irrigation, domestic and stock use;

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 7, at page 233; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1888;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed Three-fourths acre foot per acre during any 30-day period prior to June 1st, and one-half acre foot per acre during any 30-day period after June 1st, of each year; and Two and one-half acre feet per acre during any irrigation season; to be diverted under a head of not to exceed one-Fortieth of a second foot per acre.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Fifteen and one-tenth (15.1) acres in the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter; fourteen and one-tenth acres in the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter; twenty-six and eight-tenths acres in the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter; ten and nine-tenths (10.9) acres in the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter; Section Fourteen (14); nine and seven-tenths (9.7) acres in the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter; thirty-two and three-tenths (32.3) acres in the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter; Section fifteen (15); twenty and seven-tenths (20.7) acres in the Southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter; four and five-tenths (4.5) acres in the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter; Section Twenty-two (22); sixteen (16) acres in the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter; two and six-tenths (2.6) acres in the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter; Section Twenty-three (23) Township Forty (40) South Range Sixteen (16) East of Willamette Meridian; being a total of 152.7 acres.

And shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described,
