CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROGUE RIVER NATIONAL FOREST

of PO Box 520, Medford, State of Oregon 97501, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Jackson Creek and Medford Forest Service Nursery Reservoir constructed under Permit R-6727 a tributary of Bear Creek for the purpose of temperature control of 221.3 acres

under Permit No. 42460 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 23, 1977 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 6.7 cubic feet per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 as projected within D. Clinton DLC 68, Section 15, T37S, R2W, WM, ; 660 feet North and 850 feet East from SW Corner, Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre. The appropriation of water shall be limited to the period February 15 to April 1 of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
