## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That**

ROBERT GORDON ILER

of 5371 Melqua Road, Roseburg, State of Oregon 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of domestic use for one family including not to exceed one-half acre lawn or noncommercial garden irrigation under Permit No. 44706 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 24, 1980 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4) Section 24, T26S, R7W, WM; 120 feet South and 210 feet East from NE Corner Gillham DLC 46.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ----- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Woodruff DLC 38  
Section 24  
Township 26 South, Range 7 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
