CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, *That* JOHN DAVID GARCIA

of Route 3, Box 110, Elkton, State of Oregon 97436 has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of unnamed stream and two ponds, constructed under Permit R-6288

a tributary of Elk Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 5.3 acres

under Permit No. 39251 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 20, 1975 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 17, T22S, R7W, WM; 1 - 1500 feet North and 750 feet East, 2 - 1200 feet North and 770 feet East, both from S 1/4 Corner, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-6288

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre NW 1/4 SE 1/4
5.0 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 17
Township 22 South, Range 7 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
