CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN S. YOUNG

, $State\ of\ California\ 94577,\ has\ made$ of 726 Superior Avenue, San Leandro , State of California 94577, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of North and South Umpqua Rivers, water to be diverted from South Umpqua River when available with any deficiency in the available supply from South Umpqua* for the purpose of a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 39.0 acres

under Permit No. 39113 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.49 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 10 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), Lot 6 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4), Section 32, T26S, R6W, WM; 1 - 620 feet North and 20 feet West from SE Corner, Section 32; 3 - 980 feet North and 1960 feet East from W 1/4 Corner, Section 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiethof one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

River to be made up by appropriation from the North Umpqua River provided further that the total quantity of water diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.49 cubic foot per second

O.1 acre Lot 6 (SE 1/4 NW 1/4)

2.4 acres Lot 15 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)

14.0 acres Lot 22 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)

12.5 acres Lot 17 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4)

7.5 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within 0. Williams DLC 55 2.5 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within 0. Williams DLC 55
