CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROBERT A. TEN EYCK

of Route 1, Box 98, Milton-Freewater, State of Oregon, 97862, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a spring

a tributary of North Fork Walla Walla River for the purpose of domestic use for one family and stock

under Permit No. 36847 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 7, 1972 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 gallons per minute

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 23, T5N, R36E, WM; 1720 feet South and 150 feet East from NW Corner, Section 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 23
Township 5 North, Range 36 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
