## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** *That* DERALD D. WALKER

of Route 1, Box 28, Tygh Valley, State of Oregon, 97063, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a reservoir constructed under Permit R-8210

a tributary of White River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 57.9 acres

under Permit No. 45363 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 4, 1979

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 3.0 acre-feet of stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 5, T5S, R12E, WM; 1420 feet North and 310 feet West from S 1/4 Corner, Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

24.4 acres NE 1/4 SW 1/4  
20.6 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4  
0.9 acre NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 5

12.0 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4  
Section 6  
Township 5 South, Range 12 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
