CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of PO Box 773, Roseburg , State of Oregon 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River
irrigation of 3.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 30697 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 6. 1965

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.044 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 22, T27S, R6W, WM; 1560 feet North and 3090 feet West from SW Corner, Levson DLC 53

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall

 $conform\ to\ such\ reasonable\ rotation\ system\ as\ may\ be\ ordered\ by\ the\ proper\ state\ officer.$

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.8 acre NE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Stark DLC 54 2.7 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Stark DLC 54 Section 22 Township 27 South, Range 6 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 38229, Volume 30, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on July 20, 1983, approving Transfer 5288.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
