CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, ThatGEORGE H. COLLINS, MARY J. JOHN,
J.H. GOTCHER, J.H. MILLER,
GEORGE SPARLIN and ALBERT BIGELOW

of Provolt, State of Oregon, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Main Williams Creek

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of
irrigation of 53.73 acres

under Permit No. E-188 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
July 15, 1913
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.67 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 35, Lot 1 (NE 1/4
NW 1/4), Section 26, T38S, R5W, WM; 680 feet North and 200 feet East from
SW Corner, Section 35, 250 feet North and 150 feet West from the SE Corner,
Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4).

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.80 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4
18.80 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4
18.53 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
4.60 acres SW 1/4 SW 1/4

Section 26

Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the
prior certificate recorded at page 45514, Volume 38, State Record of Water
Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water
Resources Director entered on November 3, 1983, approving Transfer
Application 5336.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of
the water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
