CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That CALVIN H. KOLB

of Route 1, Box 375, Hubbard, State of Oregon 97032, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of one well

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 4.9 acres

under Permit No. G-2211 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 27, 1962 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Whitney DLC 48 Section 19, T4S, R1W, WM; 1070 feet South and 2640 feet East from NW Corner, DLC 48.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 4.7 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4 as projected within Whitney DLC 48 Section 19
 - 0.2 acre NW 1/4 NW 1/4 as projected within Whitney DLC 48 Section 20
- Township 4 South, Range 1 West, WM

This certificate is issued so as to correctly describe the location of the well and the area of use and supersedes certificate of water right recorded at page 34075, Volume 26, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
