CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ALICE LAWSON

of Freewater, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of the waters of Goodman Spring Branch

a tributary of Walla Walla River for the purpose of irrigation of 33.0 acres and domestic use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at page 466; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from that the rights of the above named Alice Lawson for the lands herein described and of Wm. Records of 7 acres in NE 1/4 NE 1/4 * that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- * Section 30, Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM, are coordinate in time and equal in right and constitute the first right to the waters of said Goodman Spring Branch

27.0 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4
6.0 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 30
Township 6 North, Range 35 East, WM

(This right is limited to the diversion of said amount of water for twenty-four hours during each of the first, second and third weeks in August and the first week in September of each year).

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 3825, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on October 28, 1983.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
