to exceed one-half acre in area under Permit No. G-5652 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 13, 1972
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.7 cubic foot per second
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the SE $1/4$ NE $1/4$ as projected within W. Herron DLC 48, Section 18, T7S, R2W, WM; Well 1 - 72 feet South and 467 feet East, Well 2 - 21 feet South and 396 feet East, both from NW Corner SE $1/4$ NE $1/4$ Section 18.
The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second per acre,
