CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, That C.J. and/or DORIS KELLEY

of 12148 Meadows Road, Central Point, State of Oregon 97502, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of three wells

a tributary of Snider Creek (Rogue River) for the purpose of Irrigation of 1.8 acres

under Permit No. G-5772 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

April 25, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.022 cubic foot per second; being 0.016 cfs from Well 1 and 0.003 cfs each from Well 2 and Well 3

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Township 35 South, Range 2 West; Well 1 - 10 feet South and 110 feet East; Well 2 - 110 feet South and 440 feet East; Well 3 - 210 feet South and 440 feet East, all from center of Section 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.8 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 15 Township 35 South, Range 2 West, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
