## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify,** *That* LLOYD M. HILL, INC.

of 4355 Turner Road, S.E., Salem, State of Oregon 97301, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Cottonwood Creek

a tributary of Bully Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 47.0 acres

under Permit No. 43658 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 3, 1978 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.59 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 3, T19S, R40E, WM; 1,130 feet North and 1,420 feet East from SW Corner Section 3

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.0 acres Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4)  
 10.4 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4  
 26.0 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4  
 0.2 acre NE 1/4 SE 1/4  
 1.4 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4  
 Section 3  
 Township 19 South, Range 40 East, WM

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
