## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume  $^4$  , at page  $^1$  ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1876

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.46 cubic foot per second.

The point of diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 5, T40S, R3W, WM; Comstock Ditch - 1000 feet North and 1190 feet East from SW Corner, Section 5.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acre SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 28

10.5 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4
7.3 acres SE 1/4 NW 1/4
Section 33
Township 39 South, Range 3 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 51584, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on February 2, 1984, approving Transfer Application 5390.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
