CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

H.H. NORTON and E.M. NORTON

of Grants Pass, State of Oregon 97526, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Munger Creek supplemented by water from John or Mule Gulch, Marble Gulch and China Gulch a tributary of Williams Creek and Rogue River for the purpose of irrigation of 24.0 acres

under Permit No. 2938 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 25, 1916

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

0.30 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 24.0 acres SE 1/4 SW 1/4

Section 34
Township 38 South, Range 5 West, WM

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior certificate recorded at page 3362, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on March 31, 1964, approving Transfer Application M-148, and not canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on February 11, 1981.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
