CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Wamic , State of Oregon 97063 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Middle Fork Gate Creek

a tributary of White River irrigation of 35.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 5651 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from October 17, 1921

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.44 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T4S, R10E, WM; 877 feet South and 2100 feet West from E $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Section 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
